11	activities and initiatives.
12	(b) The council is composed of:
13	(1) the executive head of or a designee from each of
14	the following:
15	(A) Department of Public Safety;
16	(B) Texas Military Department;
17	(C) Texas Division of Emergency Management;
18	(D) Parks and Wildlife Department;
19	(E) Texas Department of Criminal Justice; and
20	(F) Office of Court Administration of the Texas
21	Judicial System; and
22	(2) other members as determined by the governor or the
23	governor's designee.

1	(1) coordinating agency goals and responsibilities

3	(2) developing procedures for streamlining agency
