- 6 SECTION 1. Section 22.092, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) Each school year, the superintendent of a school
- 9 <u>district or chief operating officer of an open-enrollment charter</u>
- 10 school shall certify to the commissioner that the district or
- 11 school has complied with Subsection (b).
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 22.093, Education Code, is amended by
- 13 adding Subsection (k-1) to read as follows:
- 14 (k-1) Each school year, the superintendent of a school
- 15 district or chief operating officer of an open-enrollment charter
- 16 school shall certify to the commissioner that the district or
- 17 school has complied with the requirement to report misconduct under
- 18 this section.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 20 school year.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
