6	SECTION 1. Section 521.008, Transportation Code, is amended
7	to read as follows:

9	$\frac{\text{DONOR REGISTRY}}{\text{Constant}}$. (a) When a person applies for an original $\frac{1}{L}$ [or]
10	renewal, corrected, or duplicate driver's license or personal
11	identification certificate under this chapter, the person may
12	contribute \$1 or more to the <u>following:</u>
13	(1) the Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry fund
14	created under Section 692A.020, Health and Safety Code, to be used
15	for the purposes of the nonprofit organization administering the
16	Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry under Chapter 692A, Health

- 9 driver's license or personal identification certificate to
- 10 indicate that the person is voluntarily contributing \$1 to the
- 11 designated fund, account, or program, as applicable

- 13 (2) provide an opportunity for the person to
- 14 contribute \$1 to the designated fund, account, or program, as
- 15 <u>applicable</u>, [organization] during the application process for <u>an</u>

- 19 (c) The department shall remit any contribution made under

- 4 SECTION 2. Section 521.4265(a), Transportation Code, is

- 5 under this section to the comptroller for deposit to the credit of

- 7 testing account established under Section 772.00716, Government
- 8 Code], not later than the 14th day of each month. Before sending
- 9 the money to the comptroller, the department may deduct money equal
- 10 to the amount of reasonable expenses for administering this
- 11 section, not to exceed five percent of the money collected under
- 12 this section.
- 13 (d) The organization described by Subsection (a)(1) shall
- 14 submit an annual report to the director of the department that
- 15 includes the total dollar amount of contributions received by the
- 16 organization under this section.
- SECTION 5. Section 434.017(a), Government Code, is amended
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 (a) The fund for veterans' assistance is a special fund in
- 20 the state treasury outside the general revenue fund. The fund is
- 21 composed of:
- 22 (1) money transferred to the fund at the direction of
- 23 the legislature;
- 24 (2) gifts and grants contributed to the fund;
- 25 (3) the earnings of the fund;
- 26 (4) money transferred to the fund from proceeds of the
- 27 lottery game operated under Section 466.027 or transferred to the

- 8 Section 12.007, Parks and Wildlife Code; and
- 9 (8) money deposited to the credit of the fund under
- 10 Section 411.1741.
- SECTION 6. Section 692A.020(i), Health and Safety Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (i) The Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry fund is
- 14 created as a trust fund outside the state treasury to be held by the
- 15 comptroller and administered by the Department of Public Safety as
- 16 trustee on behalf of the statewide donor registry maintained for
- 17 the benefit of the citizens of this state. The fund is composed of
- 18 money deposited to the credit of the fund under Sections
- 19 502.405(b), 521.008, and 522.0295 [521.422(c)], Transportation
- 20 Code, as provided by those <u>sections</u> [subsections]. Money in the
- 21 fund shall be disbursed at least monthly, without appropriation, to
- 22 the nonprofit organization administering the registry to pay the
- 23 costs of:
- 24 (1) maintaining, operating, and updating the
- 25 Internet-based registry and establishing procedures for an
- 26 individual to be added to the registry;
- 27 (2) designing and distributing educational materials

- 1 for prospective donors as required under this section; and
- 2 (3) providing education under this chapter.
- 3 SECTION 7. Section 91.027(a), Human Resources Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) To the extent that funds are available under Sections
- 6 521.008 and 522.0295 [521.421(j) and 521.422(b)], Transportation
- 7 Code, the department shall operate a Blindness Education,
- 8 Screening, and Treatment Program to provide:
- 9 (1) blindness prevention education and screening and
- 10 treatment to prevent blindness for residents who are not covered
- 11 under an adequate health benefit plan; and
- 12 (2) transition services to individuals with visual
- 13 disabilities eligible for vocational rehabilitation services
- 14 [under Section 117.102].
- 15 SECTION 8. The following provisions of the Transportation
- 16 Code are repealed:
- 17 (1) Section 521.010;
- 18 (2) Section 521.012;
- 19 (3) Sections 521.421(j) and (k);
- 20 (4) Sections 521.422(b), (c), and (d); and
- 21 (5) Section 522.152.
- 22 SECTION 9. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 23 over another Act of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023,
- 24 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 25 codes.
- SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
