- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Title 3, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Chapter 21-A to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 21-A. CENTENNIAL PARKS CONSERVATION FUND
- 8 Sec. 21-A.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "fund" means
- 9 the centennial parks conservation fund established under Section
- 10 49-e-1, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 11 Sec. 21-A.002. USE OF CENTENNIAL PARKS CONSERVATION FUND.
- 12 Money in the fund may be spent only to:
- 13 (1) acquire state park sites from the United States or
- 14 any of its agencies, agencies of the state, or any other person;
- 15 (2) improve, develop, beautify, equip, and maintain
- 16 park sites;
- 17 (3) provide grants to political subdivisions for local
- 18 parks as provided by Chapter 24; and
- 19 (4) support department land, soil, and water
- 20 conservation efforts.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2024, but only
- 22 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 88th Legislature,
- 23 Regular Session, 2023, providing for the creation of the centennial
- 24 parks conservation fund to be administered by the Parks and

- 1 Wildlife Department is approved by the voters. If that amendment is
- 2 not approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
