- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 250.011(a), Local Government Code, as
- 7 added by Chapter 315 (H.B. 738), Acts of the 87th Legislature,
- 8 Regular Session, 2021, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by
- 10 Subsection (c), a municipality, county, or emergency services
- 11 district may not enact an ordinance, bylaw, order, building code,
- 12 or rule that in any manner requires or conditions, directly or
- 13 <u>indirectly</u>, any regulatory approval on [requiring] the
- 14 installation of a multipurpose residential fire protection
- 15 sprinkler system or any other fire protection sprinkler system in a
- 16 new or existing one- or two-family dwelling.
- 17 SECTION 2. The amendment by this Act of Section 250.011,
- 18 Local Government Code, is intended to clarify rather than change
- 19 existing law.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
