1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome
1-20 advisory council.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 119A.003, Health and Safety Code, is
1-23 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to
1-24 read as follows:

1-25 (a) The advisory council is composed of the following 19
1-26 members:

1-27 (1) one member designated by the executive
1-28 commissioner;

1-29 (2) two members of the senate appointed by the
1-30 lieutenant governor;

1-31 (3) two members of the house of representatives
1-32 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives; and

1-33 (4) 14 members appointed by the governor with the
1-34 following qualifications:

1-35 (A) three members who are health care providers,
1-36 as defined by Section 161.201;

1-37 (B) one member who is a licensed health care
1-38 provider with expertise in treating persons with pediatric
1-39 acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome, including pediatric
1-40 autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with
1-41 streptococcal infections, and autism;

1-42 [~~(B) one member who is an osteopathic physician~~
1-43 ~~with experience treating persons with pediatric acute-onset~~
1-44 ~~neuropsychiatric syndrome, including pediatric autoimmune~~

1-47 (C) one member who is a pediatrician with
1-48 experience treating persons with pediatric acute-onset
1-49 neuropsychiatric syndrome, including pediatric autoimmune

1-52 (D) one member who is a child psychiatrist with
1-53 experience treating persons with pediatric acute-onset
1-54 neuropsychiatric syndrome, including pediatric autoimmune
1-55 neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal
1-56 infections;

1-57 (E) [~~one member who is an immunologist with~~

2-9 disorder, tic disorders, and other neurological disorders;

2-10 (F) [(H)] one member who is [~~licensed by this~~
2-11 ~~state to practice as~~] a social worker;

2-12 (G) [(I)] one member who is a representative of
2-13 the Texas Education Agency with expertise in special education
2-14 services;

2-15 (H) [(J)] one member who is a psychologist
2-16 licensed under Chapter 501, Occupations Code;

2-17 (I) [(K)] one member who is a representative of a
2-18 professional organization in this state for school nurses;

2-19 (J) [(L)] one member who is a representative of
2-20 an advocacy and support group in this state for individuals
2-21 affected by pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome,
2-22 including pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders
2-23 associated with streptococcal infections;

2-24 (K) [(M)] one member who is a representative of
2-25 an advocacy and support group in this state for individuals
2-26 affected by autism; and

2-27 (L) [(N)] one member who is a parent of a child
2-28 who has been diagnosed with pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric
2-29 syndrome or autism.

2-30 (d) An advisory council member appointed under Subsection
2-31 (a)(2) or (3) may designate another individual to serve in the
2-32 member's place on the advisory council at the pleasure of the
2-33 member. An advisory council member who designates another
2-34 individual to serve in the member's place under this subsection
2-35 shall provide written notification to the chair of the advisory
2-36 council.

2-37 SECTION 2. Section 119A.005, Health and Safety Code, is
2-38 amended to read as follows:

2-39 Sec. 119A.005. CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR. Members of the
2-40 advisory council shall elect from among its [~~the legislative~~]
2-41 members by a majority vote [~~of the advisory council~~] a chair and
2-42 vice chair.

2-43 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
