4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 12.255, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (b-1) and (f) and amending Subsections (d) and
7	(e) to read as follows:
8	(b-1) A charter granted under former Section 29.259 may be
9	transferred by the charter holder to a nonprofit entity described
10	by Section 12.256 if the commissioner is provided notice of the
11	transfer.
12	(d) A charter granted under former Section 29.259 or
13	transferred by the charter holder to a nonprofit entity under
14	Subsection (b-1) may not be counted toward the limit under
15	Subsection (c).
16	(e) Except as provided by Subsection (f), a [A] nonprofit
17	entity granted a charter under the program may not enroll more than
18	350 students in an adult education program operated under that
19	charter during the first two years after the charter is granted.
20	(f) Subsection (e) [This subsection] does not apply to:
21	(1) a charter granted under former Section 29.259;

- 7 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 8 school year.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
