A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

H.B. No. 3962

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the expansion of eligibility for Medicaid to certain
3	working parents for whom federal matching money is available.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Medicaid for Texas
6	Working Families Act.

- 7 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 8 is amended by adding Section 32.02473 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 32.02473. EXPANDED ELIGIBILITY FOR MEDICAL
- 10 ASSISTANCE. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the commission
- 11 shall provide medical assistance to all persons:
- 12 (1) who are the working parent of a dependent child;
- 13 (2) who apply for the assistance; and
- 14 (3) for whom federal matching money is available.
- (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary
- 16 to implement this section.
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 32.02473, Human Resources Code, as added
- 18 by this Act, applies only to an initial determination or
- 19 recertification of eligibility of a person for medical assistance
- 20 under Chapter 32, Human Resources Code, made on or after the date
- 21 the section is implemented, regardless of the date the person
- 22 applied for that assistance.
- 23 SECTION 4. As soon as possible after the effective date of
- 24 this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human

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- 1 Services Commission shall take all necessary actions to expand
- 2 eligibility for medical assistance under Chapter 32, Human
- 3 Resources Code, in accordance with Section 32.02473, Human
- 4 Resources Code, as added by this Act, including notifying
- 5 appropriate federal agencies of that expanded eligibility.
- 6 SECTION 5. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 7 a state agency determines that any other waiver or authorization
- 8 from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that
- 9 provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the
- 10 waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision
- 11 until the waiver or authorization is granted.
- 12 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
