A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to accompanying and filming peace officers of the state
- 3 and local law enforcement agencies for producing a documentary

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 614.231, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 614.231. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
- 9 (1) "Documentary film" means a theatrically released
- 10 nonfiction motion picture dealing creatively with cultural,
- 11 artistic, historical, social, scientific, economic, or other
- 12 subjects that may have been photographed in actual occurrence, or
- 13 may employ partial reenactment, stock footage, stills, animation,
- 14 stop-motion, or other techniques, as long as the emphasis is on fact
- 15 and not fiction, including a series of films that may be released in
- 16 several parts or episodes.
- 17 <u>(2)</u> "Law enforcement agency" means an agency of this
- 18 state or a political subdivision of this state that employs peace
- 19 officers other than game wardens.
- 20 $\underline{(3)}$ [$\underline{(2)}$] "Reality television program" means a
- 21 nonfictional television program that features the same live
- 22 subjects over the course of more than one episode primarily for
- 23 entertainment purposes, but does not include a documentary film or
- 24 reporting on a matter of public concern by a journalist as defined

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
