4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 12.1168(b), Education Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(b) A financial report filed under Section 44.008 by an
8	open-enrollment charter school must separately disclose:
9	(1) <u>each</u> [all] financial <u>transaction</u> [transactions]
10	between the open-enrollment charter school and any related party,
11	separately stating the:
12	(A) relationship;
13	(B) address;
14	(C) principal;
15	(D) [7] interest;
16	(E) annual and total contract payments including
17	a description of goods or services; $[-\tau]$ and
18	(F) annual and total lease payments including a
19	description of the property; [and]
20	(2) the total compensation and benefits provided by
21	the school and any related party for each member of the governing
22	body and each officer and administrator of the school and the
23	related party <u>;</u>
24	(3) the name and address of any management company;

2	(4) fees paid during each of the preceding three years
3	to a management company or to any related party for each good,
4	service, or item, including:
5	(A) management services;
6	(B) branding or licensing;
7	(C) advertising;
8	(D) student recruitment;
9	(E) instructional costs including curriculum and
10	<pre>professional development;</pre>
11	(F) facility development;
12	(G) student uniforms; and
13	(H) teacher salaries.
14	SECTION 2. Section $44.008(f)$, Education Code, is amended to
15	read as follows:
16	(f) An open-enrollment charter school shall provide an
17	accounting of each parcel of the school's owned or leased real
18	property, including identifying the $\underline{\cdot}$
19	(1) address;
20	(2) owner;
21	(3) purpose and use of each parcel;
22	(4) name of each campus listed; and
23	(5) annual and total amount of local, state, and
24	federal funds used to purchase, lease, or improve each parcel of
25	property.
26	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
27	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
