H.B. No. 4024

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the notice required before the issuance of certain debt obligations by political subdivisions. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 1251, Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 A political subdivision with at least 250 registered 7 (b) voters on the date the governing body of the political subdivision 8 adopts the debt obligation election order must prepare a voter 9 information document for each proposition to be voted on at the 10 11 election. The political subdivision shall post the voter 12 information document in the same manner as a debt obligation election order is required to be posted under Section 4.003(f), 13 14 Election Code, and may include the voter information document in the debt obligation election order. The voter information document 15 16 must distinctly state: 17 (2) the following information formatted as a table in both the aggregate and per student capita: 18 (A) the principal of the debt obligations to be 19 20 authorized; 21 (B) the estimated interest for the debt 22 obligations to be authorized; 23 (C) the estimated combined principal and 24 interest required to pay on time and in full the debt obligations to

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1 be authorized; and 2 (D) as of the date the political subdivision 3 adopts the debt obligation election order: 4 (i) the principal of all outstanding debt 5 obligations of the political subdivision; 6 (ii) the estimated remaining interest on 7 all outstanding debt obligations of the political subdivision, which may be based on the political subdivision's expectations 8 relative to the interest due on any variable rate debt obligations; 9 10 and (iii) the estimated combined principal and 11 12 interest required to pay on time and in full all outstanding debt obligations of the political subdivision, which may be based on the 13 14 political subdivision's expectations relative to the interest due 15 on any variable rate debt obligations; 16 (3) the estimated maximum annual increase in the 17 amount of taxes that would be imposed on a residence homestead in the political subdivision with an appraised value equal to the 18 average taxable value in the jurisdiction, as determined by the 19 county appraisal district, of \$100,000 to repay the 20 debt 21 obligations to be authorized, if approved, based upon assumptions made by the governing body of the political subdivision; and 22 23 (c) The governing body of the political subdivision shall 24 identify in the voter information document the major assumptions and any underlying data used to develop the tax impact estimate made 25 26 in connection with the statement required by Subsection (b)(3),

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including:

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1 (1) the amortization of the political subdivision's 2 debt obligations, including outstanding debt obligations and the 3 proposed debt obligations;

4 (2) changes in estimated future appraised values5 within the political subdivision; and

6 (3) the assumed interest rate on the proposed debt 7 obligations.

8 (d) A political subdivision that maintains an Internet 9 website shall provide the information described by Subsection (b) 10 on its <u>website's homepage or bond election information page if it</u> 11 <u>has one, website</u> in an easily accessible manner beginning not later 12 than the 21st day before election day and ending on the day after 13 the date of the debt obligation election.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
