BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "commission" means the 5 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

6 SECTION 2. STUDY ON URANIUM DEPOSITS IN THIS STATE. The 7 commission shall conduct a study on the uranium deposits in this 8 state and how utilizing those deposits could lessen the United 9 States' reliance on foreign sources of uranium.

10 SECTION 3. REPORT. Not later than December 1, 2024, the 11 commission shall submit to the governor, lieutenant governor, and 12 speaker of the house of representatives a report that includes the 13 findings of the study and any recommendations for legislative or 14 other action. The report must include recommendations for 15 legislative or regulatory changes and potential economic incentive 16 programs to support the uranium mining industry in this state.

SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. This Act expires January 1, 2025.

18 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect 19 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members 20 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas 21 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 22 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
