| 13 | (b) Rules adopted under this section must ensure the |
| 14 | veterinarian has a reasonable opportunity to: |
| 15 | (1) assess the animal's condition and develop proposed |
| 16 | options for treatment before providing the information described by |
| 17 | Subsection (a); and |
| 18 | (2) propose additional treatment options and price |
| 19 | estimates based on changes in the animal's medical condition. |
| 20 | SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2023, the State Board |
| 21 | of Veterinary Medical Examiners shall adopt rules to implement |
| 22 | Section 801.3581, Occupations Code, as added by this Act. |
| 23 | SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. |
