A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the salary step credit for a certified career and
- 3 technology education teacher.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.403, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) A teacher, librarian, school counselor, or nurse shall
- 8 advance one step on the minimum salary schedule under Section
- 9 21.402 for each year of experience as a teacher, librarian, school
- 10 counselor, or nurse until step 20 is reached.
- 11 (b) For each year of work experience required for
- 12 certification in a career or technological field, up to a maximum of
- 13 two five years, a certified career or technology education teacher
- 14 is entitled to salary step credit as if the work experience were
- 15 teaching experience.
- 16 (c) The commissioner shall adopt rules for determining the
- 17 experience for which a teacher, librarian, school counselor, or
- 18 nurse is to be given credit in placing the teacher, librarian,
- 19 school counselor, or nurse on the minimum salary schedule. A
- 20 district shall credit the teacher, librarian, school counselor, or
- 21 nurse for each year of experience without regard to whether the
- 22 years are consecutive.
- 23 (d) As long as a teacher or librarian who received a career
- 24 ladder supplement is employed by the same school district, the

- 1 teacher or librarian is entitled to:
- 2 (1) placement on the minimum salary schedule at the
- 3 step above the step on which the teacher would otherwise be placed,
- 4 if the teacher or librarian received a career ladder supplement for
- 5 level two of the career ladder on August 31, 1993; or
- 6 (2) placement on the minimum salary schedule at the
- 7 step two steps above the step on which the teacher would otherwise
- 8 be placed, if the teacher or librarian received a career ladder
- 9 supplement for level three of the career ladder on August 31, 1993.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 823.404, Government Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (a) An eligible member may establish equivalent membership
- 13 service credit for up to a maximum of five one or two years of work
- 14 experience for which the member is entitled to salary step credit
- 15 under Section 21.403(b), Education Code.
- 16 (b) A member is eligible to establish equivalent membership
- 17 service credit under this section if the member has at least five
- 18 years of membership service credit.
- 19 (c) A member may establish credit under this section by
- 20 depositing with the retirement system, for each year of service,
- 21 the actuarial present value, at the time of deposit, of the
- 22 additional standard retirement annuity benefits that would be
- 23 attributable to the conversion of the work experience into service
- 24 credit based on rates and tables recommended by the actuary and
- 25 adopted by the board of trustees.
- 26 (d) After a member makes the deposits required by this
- 27 section, the retirement system shall grant the member one year of

- 1 equivalent membership service credit for each year of service
- 2 approved.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
