- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 401.004(a), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Subject to Section 401.0045, a [A] person may contribute
- 8 funds, services, or other things of value to pay the expenses of or
- 9 otherwise provide for an inauguration. This contribution is not a
- 10 political contribution for purposes of state law regulating
- 11 political contributions or prohibiting a contribution by a
- 12 corporation or labor organization.
- 13 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 401, Government Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 401.0045 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 401.0045. INAUGURAL CONTRIBUTION LIMITS; DISCLOSURE
- 16 STATEMENT. (a) In this section "political committee" has the
- 17 meaning assigned by Section 251.001, Election Code.
- (b) Inaugural contributions made by a person under Section
- 19 401.004 are subject to the following contribution limits:
- 20 (1) for a person other than a person described by
- 21 Subdivision (3), the total amount of contributions may not exceed
- 22 \$2,500;
- 23 (2) for a political committee, the total amount of
- 24 contributions may not exceed \$7,500; and

1	(3) for a corporation that does business with this
2	state or an officer or other representative of the corporation, the
3	total amount of contributions may not exceed \$7,500.
4	(c) Not later than the 30th day after the date of the
5	inauguration, the inaugural committee shall provide to the Texas
6	Ethics Commission a disclosure statement on the total inaugural
7	contributions received by the committee and the total expenditures
8	made by the committee for the inauguration. The disclosure
9	<pre>statement must include:</pre>
10	(1) if the total contributions or expenditures do not
11	exceed \$1,000, a statement that the contributions received or the
12	expenditures made, as applicable, do not exceed that amount; or
13	(2) if the total contributions or expenditures exceed
14	\$1,000, an itemized statement of the following:
15	(A) for each contribution of \$500 or more:
16	(i) the full name and principal address of
17	the person making the contribution;
18	(ii) the amount of the contribution; and
19	(iii) the date the contribution was
20	received by the committee;
21	(B) for all contributions of less than \$500, the
22	total amount of those contributions;
23	(C) for each person paid \$500 or more by the
24	<pre>committee:</pre>
25	(i) the full name and principal address of
26	the person;
27	(ii) the total amount haid to the herson.

- (D) for all persons paid less than \$500 by the
- 5 <u>committee:</u>
- 6 <u>(i) the total amount of those expenditures;</u>
- 7 <u>and</u>
- 8 <u>(ii)</u> the total amount for each category of

- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 11 inaugural contributions or expenditures made on or after the
- 12 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
