## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the regulation by the Texas Commission on Environmental
- 3 Quality of the discharge of preproduction plastic.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 26.0135(a), Water Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 8 the strategic and comprehensive monitoring of water quality and the 9 periodic assessment of water quality in each watershed and river

To ensure clean water, the commission shall establish

- 10 basin of the state. In order to conserve public funds and avoid
- 11 duplication of effort, subject to adequate funding under Section
- 12 26.0291, river authorities shall, to the greatest extent possible
- 13 and under the supervision of the commission, conduct water quality

monitoring and assessments in their own watersheds.

15 monitoring and assessments involving agricultural or silvicultural

nonpoint source pollution shall be coordinated through the State

Soil and Water Conservation Board with local soil and water

- 18 conservation districts. The water quality monitoring and reporting
- 19 duties under this section apply only to a river authority that has
- 20 entered into an agreement with the commission to perform those
- 21 duties. The commission, either directly or through cooperative
- 22 agreements and contracts with local governments, shall conduct
- 23 monitoring and assessments of watersheds where a river authority is
- 24 unable to perform an adequate assessment of its own watershed. The

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monitoring program shall provide data to identify significant 1 long-term water quality trends, characterize water 2 3 support the permitting process, and unclassified waters. The commission shall consider available 4 5 monitoring data and assessment results in developing or reviewing wastewater permits and stream standards and in conducting other 6 water quality management activities. The assessment must include a 7 8 review of wastewater discharges, nonpoint source pollution, pollution from preproduction plastic, as defined by Section 26.023, 9 10 nutrient loading, toxic materials, biological health of aquatic life, public education and involvement in water quality issues, 11 12 local and regional pollution prevention efforts, and other factors that affect water quality within the watershed. The monitoring and 13 14 assessment required by this section is a continuing duty, and the 15 monitoring and assessment shall be periodically revised to show changes in the factors subject to assessment. 16

Sec. 26.023. WATER QUALITY STANDARDS. (a) The commission 19 by rule shall set water quality standards for the water in the state 20 and may amend the standards from time to time. The commission has 21 the sole and exclusive authority to set water quality standards for 22 all water in the state. The commission shall consider the existence 23 24 and effects of nonpoint source pollution, preproduction plastic pollution, toxic materials, and nutrient loading in developing 25 26 water quality standards and related waste load models for water The commission shall develop standards based on all 27 quality.

SECTION 2. Section 26.023, Water Code, is amended to read as

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follows:

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- 1 quality assured data obtained by the commission, including the

- 4 (b) In this section:
- 5 (1) "Preproduction plastic" means pre-consumer
- 6 plastic resin, consisting of organic polymers and additives, in the
- 7 form of pellets, powder, flakes, or powdered additives.
- 8 (2) "Quality[, "quality] assured data" has the meaning
- 9 assigned by Section 26.0135(i).
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
