- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 122, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 122.009 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 122.009. COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL REGULATION OF AUTOMATED
- 8 EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS. (a) In this section, "automated external
- 9 defibrillator" has the meaning assigned by Section 779.001.
- (b) After public notice and hearing, a county or
- 11 municipality by order or ordinance may require automated external
- 12 defibrillators to be installed and maintained in structures subject
- 13 to county or municipal licensure or other regulation to provide
- 14 adequate emergency preparedness. The order or ordinance:
- 15 (1) may specify the structures subject to the
- 16 requirement and the minimum number and position of required
- 17 automated external defibrillators;
- 18 (2) may not apply to a health facility licensed under
- 19 Title 4 or a premises with an occupancy limit of 30 or fewer
- 20 persons; and

- 21 (3) may provide exceptions and a variance process to
- 22 <u>ensure small businesses are not adversely impacted.</u>
- 23 <u>(c) The governing body of a municipality or the</u>
- 24 commissioners court of a county shall consult with the county or

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- 1 municipal fire marshal, the county or municipal fire chief, or
- 2 other local official with authority over emergency matters to
- 3 determine whether to require automated external defibrillators
- 4 under Subsection (b) and the structures subject to the requirement.
- 5 (d) A county order adopted under Subsection (b) does not
- 6 apply to structures within a municipality and the municipality's
- 7 <u>extraterritorial jurisdiction if the municipality has adopted an</u>
- 8 ordinance under Subsection (b). A municipal ordinance may apply to
- 9 structures within the municipality's extraterritorial
- 10 jurisdiction.
- 11 (e) A county or municipality:
- 12 (1) may inspect a structure subject to an order or
- 13 ordinance adopted under Subsection (b) to ensure compliance with
- 14 the order or ordinance; and
- 15 (2) may not impose application or inspection fees
- 16 related to an order or ordinance adopted under Subsection (b).
- 17 (f) Chapter 779 applies to automated external
- 18 defibrillators required under an order or ordinance adopted under
- 19 Subsection (b).
- 20 (g) A county or municipality and county or municipal elected
- 21 or appointed officials, employees, and agents are not liable for
- 22 the regulation of or failure to regulate automated external
- 23 defibrillators.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
