A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to disciplinary action against a peace officer for failure to comply with certain arrest and charging procedures for 3 violations of the rules of the road. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 543.008, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 543.008. VIOLATION BY OFFICER. (a) Subject to 8 Subsection (b), a [A] violation by an officer of a provision of 9 Sections 543.003-543.007 is misconduct in office and the officer is 10 11 subject to removal from the officer's position. 12 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply if an officer issues a person a written notice to appear in accordance with Section 13 14 543.003 and: 15 (1) the person refuses to sign the written notice prepared by the officer in accordance with Section 543.005; 16 (2) the officer does not take the person before a 17 magistrate under Section 543.002 after the person fails to sign the 18 written notice; and 19 (3) the officer does not violate any other provision 20 21 of Sections 543.003-543.007. SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 22 conduct that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. 23 Conduct that occurs before the effective date of this Act is 24

1 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date 2 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that 3 purpose.
