Subchapter Z, Chapter 552, Local Government 4 5 Code, is amended by adding Section 552.915 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 552.915. PROHIBITION ON TRANSFER OF MUNICIPAL UTILITY REVENUE. (a) In this section: 7 (1) "Municipal utility" means a utility system owned, 8 9 operated, or controlled by a municipality. (2) "Utility system" has the meaning assigned by 10 Section 552.914. 11 12 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a municipality may not transfer revenue from a municipal utility that provides electric 13 14 service to the general fund of the municipality in a fiscal year if the commission determines under Section 38.101, Utilities Code, 15 that the utility's vegetation management activities are 16 insufficient to ensure reliable service in that year. 17 18 SECTION 2. Section 38.101, Utilities Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 Sec. 38.101. REPORT ON INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT 20 AND 21 MAINTENANCE. (a) Not later than May 1 of each year, each electric utility and municipally owned utility shall submit to the 22 commission a report describing the utility's activities related to: 23 24 (1) identifying areas that are susceptible to damage

(b) Each electric utility and municipally owned utility 5 6 shall include in a report required under Subsection (a) a summary of the utility's activities related to preparing for emergency 7 operations. 8 (c) The commission shall evaluate each report submitted by a 9 municipally owned utility under this section and notify the utility 10 if the commission determines that the utility's vegetation 11 management activities are insufficient to ensure reliable service. 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 13
