 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the qualifications to serve as a member of a board of  
 1-24 trustees of a military reservation school district and rules  
 1-25 adopted by the State Board of Education for the governance of a  
 1-26 special-purpose district.

1-27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-28 SECTION 1. Sections 11.352(b) and (c), Education Code, are  
 1-29 amended to read as follows:

1-30 (b) For each military reservation school district, the  
 1-31 State Board of Education may appoint a board of three or five  
 1-32 trustees. Enlisted military personnel and military officers may be  
 1-33 appointed to the school board. A majority of the trustees appointed  
 1-34 for the district must be civilians and all may be civilians. The  
 1-35 trustees shall be selected from a list of persons who are qualified  
 1-36 to serve as members of a school district board of trustees under  
 1-37 Section 11.061 and who live on or are employed on the military  
 1-38 reservation. A person who retires from active duty or civilian  
 1-39 service while serving a term as a member of the board of trustees  
 1-40 may continue to serve for the remainder of that person's term. The  
 1-41 list shall be furnished to the board by the commanding officer of  
 1-42 the military reservation. The trustees appointed serve terms of  
 1-43 two years.

1-44 (c) The State Board of Education shall ~~may~~ adopt rules for  
 1-45 the governance of a special-purpose district. In the absence of a  
 1-46 rule adopted under this subsection, the laws applicable to  
 1-47 independent school districts apply to a special-purpose district.

1-48 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
