- 15 (e) The training under Subsection (d) may be:
- 16 (1) offered to providers who provide care for children
- in the conservatorship of the department who are younger than 10 17
- years of age who have a history of running away; 18
- (2) included as part of existing licensing training 19
- provided by the department or contracted residential child-care 20
- providers; and 21
- 22 (3) offered in lieu of required training that is not
- 23 relevant based on the age of the children for whom the person will
- 24 be providing care.
