- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 264.015, Family Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 8 (d) Each foster parent, prospective adoptive parent, and
- 9 relative or other designated caregiver shall complete a training
- 10 program developed by the department on runaway prevention measures
- 11 and proper procedures in the event of a runaway event to support
- 12 children and youth in the conservatorship of the department at high
- 13 risk for running away from the child's substitute care provider.
- 14 This training program may be included as part of existing training
- 15 courses already provided by the Department of Family and Protective
- 16 Services.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
