- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Chapter 95, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 95.005 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 95.005. LIMITED LIABILITY FOR ELECTION NOT TO MAINTAIN
- 10 WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN PROJECTS. (a)
- 11 In this section, "insurance restoration project" means work
- 12 performed to repair a home, business, or other structure following
- 13 <u>a fire, a natural disaster, water damage, or mold damage and for</u>
- 14 which the work is or will be compensated by insurance.
- 15 (b) Notwithstanding Section 95.003, a property owner is not
- 16 liable for personal injury or death to a contractor, subcontractor,
- 17 or employee of a contractor or subcontractor arising from work on an
- 18 <u>insurance restoration project if the contractor or subcontractor</u>
- 19 does not maintain workers' compensation insurance coverage under
- 20 Chapter 406, Labor Code.
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 23 this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
