- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 74.3013(f), Property Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (f) During a state fiscal year the total amount of money
- 9 that may be transferred by all nonprofit cooperative corporations
- 10 under this section may not exceed 50 percent of the total money
- 11 reported for that year by those nonprofit cooperative corporations
- 12 [\$2 million]. [No more than 20 percent of each nonprofit
- 13 cooperative's funds eligible for delivery under this section shall
- 14 be used for economic development.] The comptroller shall adopt
- 15 procedures to record the total amount of money transferred
- 16 annually.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
