| 5 | SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is |
| 6 | amended by adding Chapter 541 to read as follows: |
| 7 | CHAPTER 54. KETAMINE TREATMENT GRANT PROGRAM |
| 8 | Sec. 54.001. KETAMINE TREATMENT GRANT PROGRAM. The |
| 9 | commission shall establish a ketamine treatment grant program for |
| 10 | ketamine infusion clinics that serve veterans, active-duty |
| 11 | military, and first responders. |
| 12 | Sec. 542.002. USE OF GRANT. A ketamine infusion clinic |
| 13 | awarded a grant under this chapter may use grant money to: |
| 14 | (1) provide otherwise uncompensated treatment to: |
| 15 | (i) veterans; |
| 16 | (ii) active-duty military; and |
| 17 | (iii) first responders; and |
| 18 | (2) pay for other activities, services, supplies, |
| 19 | resources, and equipment the commission determines necessary for |
| 20 | the facility to provide these services. |
| 21 | Sec. 54.003. SELECTION OF GRANT RECIPIENTS. The commission |
| 22 | with any necessary assistance of physicians or other providers may |
| 23 | select eligible facilities to receive a grant under this chapter. |
| 24 | Sec. 54.004. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS. The commission |

- 1 may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and donations from any public
- 2 or private source for the purposes of this chapter.
- 3 Sec. 541.005. WORK GROUP. (a) The commission may establish
- 4 a program work group to:
- 5 (1) assist the commission with developing,
- 6 implementing, or evaluating the program; and
- 7 (2) prepare a report on the results and outcomes of the
- 8 grants awarded under this chapter.
- 9 (b) A member of a program work group established under this
- 10 section is not entitled to compensation for serving on the program
- 11 work group and may not be reimbursed for travel or other expenses
- 12 incurred while conducting the business of the program work group.
- 13 (c) A program work group established under this section is
- 14 not subject to Chapter 2110.
- 15 Sec. 541.006. REPORT TO GOVERNOR AND LEGISLATURE. Not
- 16 later than December 1 of each even-numbered year, the commission
- 17 shall submit a report to the governor and members of the legislature
- 18 regarding the activities of the program and grant recipients,
- 19 including the results and outcomes of grants awarded under this
- 20 chapter.
- 21 Sec. 541.007. RULES. The executive commissioner may adopt
- 22 rules necessary to implement this chapter.
- Sec. 541.008. SPECIFIC APPROPRIATION REQUIRED. The
- 24 commission may not spend state funds to accomplish the purposes of
- 25 this chapter and is not required to award a grant under this chapter
- 26 unless money is appropriated for the purposes of this chapter.
- 27 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2023, the Health and

- 1 Human Services Commission shall establish and implement the
- 2 ketamine treatment grant program authorized by Chapter 54, Health
- 3 and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2024, the Health and
- 5 Human Services Commission shall provide the initial report to the
- 6 governor and the legislature as required by Section 54.006, Health
- 7 & Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
