- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 21 ballot proposition for a constitutional amendment proposed by the
- 22 legislature on or after the effective date of this Act. A ballot
- 23 proposition for a constitutional amendment proposed by the
- 24 legislature before the effective date of this Act is governed by the

- 1 law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 2 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
