## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 380.001, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The governing body of a municipality may not establish,
- 8 amend, or renew a program under Subsection (a) unless the governing
- 9 body has first held a public hearing on the matter at which members
- 10 of the public are given the opportunity to be heard.
- 11 (e) A municipality may not make a loan or grant of public
- 12 money or provide municipal personnel or services to a person
- 13 through a program established under this section unless the
- 14 municipality enters into a written agreement with the person. The
- 15 agreement must detail the terms and conditions of the loan, grant,
- 16 or provision of municipal personnel or services. An agreement with
- 17 a for-profit entity must require the creation or retention of jobs
- 18 and the making of a capital investment, and must include a schedule
- 19 of the jobs to be created or retained and the capital investment to
- 20 be made. An agreement must include a requirement that the person
- 21 repay to the municipality the cost of any benefit received by the
- 22 person from the municipality under the agreement if the person
- 23 fails to meet each performance requirement required by the
- 24 agreement.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Section 380.002, Local Government Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 3 (d) A home-rule municipality may not grant public money to
- 4 an organization or corporation under this section or through a
- 5 program established under this section unless the municipality
- 6 complies with the requirements of Sections 380.001(d) and (e).
- 7 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 8 an agreement entered into by a municipality under Section 380.001
- 9 or 380.002, Local Government Code, as amended by this Act, on or
- 10 after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
