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H.B. No. 4358

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to including digital teaching in the micro-credential 3 certification program for public school educator continuing 4 education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 21.054, Education Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsections (a) and (i) and adding Subsection (i-1) to 8 read as follows:

9 (a) The board shall propose rules establishing a process for 10 identifying continuing education courses and programs that fulfill 11 educators' continuing education requirements, including 12 opportunities for educators to receive micro-credentials, as 13 provided by Subsection (i), in:

14 <u>(1)</u> fields of study related to the educator's 15 certification class; or

16 (2) digital teaching [as provided by Subsection (i)]. The board shall propose rules establishing a program to 17 (i) issue micro-credentials in fields of study related to an educator's 18 certification class or in digital teaching. The agency shall 19 approve continuing education providers to offer micro-credential 20 21 courses. A micro-credential received by an educator shall be recorded on the agency's Educator Certification Online System 22 23 (ECOS) and included as part of the educator's public certification 24 records.

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<u>(i-1) In proposing rules under Subsection (i) for</u>
micro-credentials related to digital teaching, the board shall
<u>engage relevant stakeholders.</u>

4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 5 school year.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
