Subchapter D, Chapter 120, Business & Commerce Code, is amended by adding Sections 120.152 and 120.153 to read as 6 7 follows: Sec. 120.152. ATTORNEY GENERAL INVESTIGATIVE AUTHORITY. If 8 9 the attorney general has reason to believe that a person has engaged in, is engaging in, or is about to engage in a violation of this 10 chapter, the attorney general may issue a civil investigative 11 demand. The procedures established for the issuance of a civil 12 investigative demand under Section 15.10 apply to the same extent 13 14 and manner to the issuance of a civil investigative demand under this section. The attorney general may seek an order from the 15 16 district court compelling compliance with a civil investigative demand issued under this section. 17 Sec. 120.153. DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE. A violation of 18 this chapter is a false, misleading, or deceptive act or practice 19 under Subchapter E, Chapter 17, and is actionable under that 20 21 subchapter. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
