H.B. No. 4408

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment of a strategic fuel reserve program 3 in this state. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 418, Government Code, is amended by adding Subchapter K to read as follows: 6 7 SUBCHAPTER K. STRATEGIC FUEL RESERVE PROGRAM Sec. 418.351. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter: 8 (1) "Commission" means the Railroad Commission of 9 10 Texas. 11 (2) "Gas" means natural gas. 12 (3) "Petroleum product" means any product derived by refining petroleum and intended to produce power by burning the 13 product. 14 (4) "Program" means the strategic fuel reserve program 15 16 established under this subchapter. Sec. 418.352. PROGRAM ESTABLISHMENT AND PURPOSE. 17 The commission shall establish a program for acquiring and maintaining 18 a strategic fuel reserve of gas and petroleum products for 19 distribution in this state in the event of a disaster to reduce the 20 impact of disruptions in supplies of the gas and petroleum products 21 22 in this state. 23 Sec. 418.353. GUIDELINE FOR PROGRAM ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION. The program must be established and operated in a manner 24

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that substantially reduces this state's vulnerability to an energy 2 emergency while considering the energy needs and infrastructure of 3 each region of this state. 4 Sec. 418.354. POWERS; EXCEPTION. (a) Except as provided by 5 Subsection (b), the commission may purchase, sell, and lease property, including gas and petroleum products, and take any other 6 7 action reasonable and necessary to establish and operate the 8 program. 9 The commission may not distribute gas or petroleum (b) 10 products maintained as part of the strategic fuel reserve unless the governor declares a state of disaster and directs the 11 12 distribution or determines that a disaster has occurred in another state and that state is in need of gas or petroleum products. 13 14 (c) The governor may direct the distribution of not more 15 than 30 percent of the gas or petroleum products in the strategic fuel reserve to another state under Subsection (b). 16 Sec. 418.355. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS. The strategic fuel 17 reserve established under this subchapter must have the capacity to 18 19 hold at least the amount of gas and petroleum products needed to provide fuel and power for this state for a period of at least 30 20 days in the event of a disaster that would likely disrupt the 21 regular distribution of gas and petroleum products throughout this 22 state. The commission shall maintain at least that amount of gas 23 24 and petroleum products in the reserve except when gas and petroleum products are being distributed in response to a disaster and for a 25 26 reasonable time needed to replenish the reserve after a disaster. 27 Sec. 418.356. RULEMAKING. The commission, in consultation

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with the governor, shall adopt rules as necessary to implement this subchapter, including rules governing the distribution of gas or petroleum products maintained as part of the strategic fuel reserve in the event of a disaster. SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective

6 date of this Act, the Railroad Commission of Texas shall adopt any 7 rules necessary to implement Subchapter K, Chapter 418, Government 8 Code, as added by this Act.

9 (b) After the strategic fuel reserve program described by Section 418.352, Government Code, as added by this Act, is 10 established, the Texas Division of Emergency Management shall 11 12 revise the state emergency management plan described by Section 418.042, Government Code, and the state emergency management plan 13 14 annex described by Section 418.0425, Government Code, to account 15 for the establishment and operation of a strategic fuel reserve program under Section 1 of this Act. 16

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
