## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to crosswalk marking requirements. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 544, Transportation Code, is amended by 5 adding Section 544.014 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 544.014. CROSSWALK MARKING REQUIREMENTS. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, a local authority shall indicate a 7 marked crosswalk with one of the following: 8 9 (1) solid white lines that are longitudinal, transverse, or diagonal; or 10 11 (2) a Texas-themed mural described by Subsection (b). 12 (b) A Texas-themed mural authorized by Subsection (a)(2) 13 must: 14 (1) completely fill the boundaries of the marked 15 crosswalk; (2) have a white, black, or unpainted background; and 16 (3) feature the shape of the State of Texas, painted in 17 the manner of the Texas flag. 18 (c) A municipality with a population of 100,000 or more 19 shall identify the five intersections that are most used by 20 21 pedestrians in the municipality and indicate each marked crosswalk in those intersections with a Texas-themed mural described by 22 23 Subsection (b). SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding Section 544.014(c), 24

Transportation Code, as added by this Act, a municipality is not 1 required to comply with that subsection until September 1, 2025. 2

(b) Not later than September 1, 2025, each municipality with 3 4 a population of 100,000 or more shall conduct a study to identify 5 the five intersections that are most used by pedestrians in the 6 municipality.
