- 11 SECTION 2. Section 28.0253(e), Education Code, is amended

- 13 (e) A school district or open-enrollment charter school
- 14 shall allow a student to graduate and receive [may issue] a high
- 15 school diploma [to a student] under the program if, using the
- 16 standards established under Subsection (c), the student
- 17 demonstrates mastery of and early readiness for college in each of
- 18 the subject areas described by that subsection and in a language
- 19 other than English, notwithstanding any other local or state
- 20 requirements.
- SECTION 3. Section 56.221(2), Education Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (2) "Eligible institution" means an institution of
- 24 higher education, as that term is defined by Section 61.003[, that

- 1 is designated as a research university or emerging research
- 2 university under the coordinating board's accountability system].
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
