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- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 11, Water Code, is amended
- 2 by adding Section 11.2011 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 11.2011. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter, other than
- 4 Sections 11.202(c) and 11.206, applies only to an artesian well
- 5 drilled outside the boundaries of a groundwater conservation
- 6 district, subsidence district, or other conservation and
- 7 reclamation district with the authority to regulate the drilling,
- 8 spacing, or production of water wells.
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 36.001, Water Code, is amended by adding
- 10 Subdivision (2-a) and amending Subdivisions (8) and (9) to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 (2-a) "Conservation" means the practice of reducing
- 13 the consumption of water, reducing the loss or waste of water,
- 14 improving the efficiency in the use of water, or increasing the
- 15 recycling and reuse of water so that a water supply is made
- 16 <u>available for future or alternative uses.</u>
- 17 (8) "Waste" means any one or more of the following:
- 18 (A) withdrawal of groundwater from a groundwater
- 19 reservoir at a rate and in an amount that causes or threatens to
- 20 cause intrusion into the reservoir of water unsuitable for
- 21 agricultural, gardening, domestic, or stock raising purposes;
- 22 (B) the flowing or producing of wells from a
- 23 groundwater reservoir if the water produced is not used for a
- 24 beneficial purpose;
- (C) escape of groundwater from a groundwater
- 26 reservoir to any other reservoir or geologic strata that does not
- 27 contain groundwater;

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- 1 (D) pollution or harmful alteration of
- 2 groundwater in a groundwater reservoir by saltwater or by other
- 3 deleterious matter admitted from another stratum or from the
- 4 surface of the ground;
- 5 (E) willfully or negligently causing, suffering,
- 6 or allowing groundwater to escape into any river, creek, natural
- 7 watercourse, depression, lake, reservoir, drain, sewer, street,
- 8 highway, road, or road ditch, or onto any land other than that of
- 9 the owner of the well unless such discharge is authorized by permit,
- 10 rule, or order issued by the commission under Chapter 26;
- 11 (F) groundwater pumped for irrigation that
- 12 escapes as irrigation tailwater onto land other than that of the
- 13 owner of the well unless permission has been granted by the occupant
- 14 of the land receiving the discharge; [ex]
- 15 (G) the production or use of groundwater in an
- 16 <u>amount that exceeds the amount reasonably necessary for the purpose</u>
- 17 for which the groundwater is needed, not including the production
- 18 or use of groundwater for agricultural irrigation as necessary to
- 19 comply with federal crop insurance standards and guidelines; or
- 20 (H) drilling, completing, maintaining, or
- 21 operating a well that is not in compliance with the requirements of
- 22 Chapter 1901, Occupations Code, or applicable rules adopted under
- 23 that chapter [for water produced from an artesian well, "waste"
- 24 also has the meaning assigned by Section 11.205].
- 25 (9) "Use for a beneficial purpose" means the
- 26 nonwasteful use of groundwater for:
- 27 (A) agricultural, gardening, domestic, stock

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- 1 raising, municipal, mining, manufacturing, industrial, commercial,
- 2 recreational, or pleasure purposes;
- 3 (B) exploring for, producing, handling, or
- 4 treating oil, gas, sulphur, or other minerals; or
- 5 (C) any other purpose that is useful and
- 6 beneficial to the user.
- 7 SECTION 4. The following provisions of the Water Code are
- 8 repealed:
- 9 (1) Sections 11.202(d) and (e);
- 10 (2) Section 11.203;
- 11 (3) Section 11.204; and
- 12 (4) Section 11.207.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
