## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a report by the Texas Workforce Commission regarding apprenticeship opportunities in this state for emerging and 3 high-demand industries. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is amended by adding Section 302.0191 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 302.0191. REPORT ON AVAILABLE APPRENTICESHIPS. (a) 8 9 In this section: (1) "Apprenticeship program" includes: 10 11 (A) an industry-recognized training program, as 12 defined by Section 302.252; and 13 (B) an apprenticeship training program, as 14 defined by Section 133.001, Education Code. (2) "Emerging and high-demand industry" means an 15 industry or occupation described by the report required under 16 Section 302.019. 17 18 (b) Not later than September 1 of each year, the commission shall, in consultation with each local workforce development board, 19 prepare and submit to the legislature a report on available 20 21 apprenticeship programs in this state and make recommendations to expand the availability of apprenticeship programs in emerging and 22 23 high-demand industries. The report must: 24 (1) include data on:

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1 (A) the total number of active apprenticeship 2 programs, categorized by the industries included in the North 3 American Industry Classification System; 4 (B) the total number of active apprentices, 5 categorized by the industries included in the North American Industry Classification System; and 6 7 (C) the total occupational demand for each 8 industry, categorized by each occupation in the industry for which an apprenticeship program may be established; and 9 10 (2) make recommendations to expand available apprenticeship programs for emerging and high-demand industries 11 12 with higher employment demand relative to the total number of 13 active apprentices and apprenticeship programs. 14 (c) The commission may collaborate and consult with the 15 council or the Apprenticeship and Training Advisory Committee, as designated by the council, to develop recommendations for the 16 17 report under Subsection (b). (d) The commission shall provide a copy of the report to the 18 19 council or the Apprenticeship and Training Advisory Committee, as designated by the council, at the same time as the report required 20 under Section 133.006(b), Education Code. 21 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2024, the commission 22 shall prepare and submit the initial report required by Section 23 24 302.0191, Labor Code, as added by this Act. 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
