BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

NAVIGATION 6 SECTION 1. STUDY ON ECONOMIC IMPACT OF 7 DISTRICTS. (a) The Texas A&M Transportation Institute shall conduct a study to examine the economic impact and potential for 8 economic growth of navigation districts in this state. The study 9 shall determine: 10

11 (1) the direct economic impact of each navigation 12 district on the economy of this state;

13 (2) the total population located in the boundaries of14 each navigation district; and

(3) the projected economic growth over the next 10years for each navigation district.

(b) In addition to the requirements of Subsection (a) of this section, the study shall determine the economic impact, population, and projected economic growth of each navigation district at the county level.

21 SECTION 2. REPORT. Not later than December 1, 2024, the 22 Texas A&M Transportation Institute shall submit to the lieutenant 23 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and each 24 member of the legislature a written report containing the results
