## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the renewal and review of certain air quality permits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 3

SECTION 1. Sections 382.05195(e), (f), and (k), Health and 4 5 Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:

- (e) The commission by rule shall establish procedures for 7 the amendment of a standard permit and for an application for, the issuance of, the renewal of, and the revocation of an authorization 8 9 to use a standard permit. The commission shall evaluate the protectiveness of each standard permit issued under this section at 10 least once every six years. Each authorization to use a standard 11 permit issued under this section is subject to review at least once 12
- every six years to determine whether the authority to operate 13
- 14 should be renewed.

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- The commission shall require a [A] facility authorized 15 16 to emit air contaminants under a standard permit to [shall] comply 17 with an amendment to the standard permit beginning on  $\underline{a}$  [the] date that is not later than the date the facility's authorization to use 18 the standard permit is renewed [or the date the commission 19 20 otherwise provides]. Before the date the facility is required to comply with the amendment, the standard permit, as it read before 21
- 23 (k) An application for an authorization to use [the issuance 24 of] a standard permit under this section for a concrete plant that

the amendment, applies to the facility.

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- 1 performs wet batching, dry batching, or central mixing, including a
- 2 permanent, temporary, or specialty concrete batch plant, as defined
- 3 by the commission, must include a plot plan that clearly shows:
- 4 (1) a distance scale;
- 5 (2) a north arrow;
- 6 (3) all property lines, emission points, buildings,
- 7 tanks, and process vessels and other process equipment in the area
- 8 in which the facility will be located;
- 9 (4) at least two benchmark locations in the area in
- 10 which the facility will be located; and
- 11 (5) if the permit requires a distance, setback, or
- 12 buffer from other property or structures as a condition of the
- 13 permit, whether the required distance or setback will be met.
- SECTION 2. Section 382.05198(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (c) An application for <u>an authorization to use</u> [the issuance
- 0 a standard permit under this section must include a plot plan
- 18 that meets the requirements of Section 382.05195(k).
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 382.055(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) A preconstruction permit issued or renewed by the
- 22 commission is subject to review to determine whether the authority
- 23 to operate should be renewed according to the following schedule:
- 24 (1) a preconstruction permit issued before December 1,
- 25 1991, is subject to review not later than 15 years after the date of
- 26 issuance;
- 27 (2) a preconstruction permit issued on or after

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1 December 1, 1991, is subject to review:
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- 2 (A) every  $\underline{six}$  [ $\frac{10}{10}$ ] years after the date of
- 3 issuance; or
- 4 (B) on the filing of an application for an
- 5 amendment to the permit, if:
- 6 (i) the applicant is subject to Section
- 7 382.056;
- 8 (ii) the application is filed with the
- 9 commission not more than three years before the date the permit is
- 10 scheduled to expire; and
- 11 (iii) the applicant does not object to
- 12 having the permit subjected to review at that time; and
- 13 (3) for cause, a preconstruction permit issued on or
- 14 after December 1, 1991, for a facility at a nonfederal source may
- 15 contain a provision requiring the permit to be renewed at a period
- 16 of between five and six [10] years.
- SECTION 4. (a) Not later than March 1, 2024, the Texas
- 18 Commission on Environmental Quality shall adopt rules necessary to
- 19 implement the changes in law made by this Act.
- 20 (b) After the effective date of this Act, notwithstanding
- 21 the changes in law made by this Act to Sections 382.05195 and
- 22 382.055, Health and Safety Code, the Texas Commission on
- 23 Environmental Quality may authorize the use of a permit or
- 24 authorization to use a permit issued before the effective date of
- 25 this Act until the date the permit or authorization would have been
- 26 eligible for renewal under the law in effect immediately before the
- 27 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in

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- 1 effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
