8	applicant for or the holder of a license that authorizes the person
9	to provide:
10	(1) law enforcement or public health, education, or
11	safety services, except for services provided by a person licensed
12	by the Texas Board of Nursing; or
13	(2) financial services in an industry regulated by a
14	person listed in Section 411.0765(b)(18), Government Code.
15	SECTION 2. Section 52.0211, Occupations Code, is amended by
16	amending Subsection (a) to read as follows:
17	(a) This section does not apply to an applicant for a
18	license that would allow the applicant to provide:
19	(1) law enforcement services;
20	(2) public health, education, or safety services,
21	except for services provided by a person licensed by the Texas Board
22	<u>of Nursing</u> ; or
23	(3) financial services in an industry regulated by the
24	securities commissioner, the banking commissioner, the savings and

1 mortgage lending commissioner, the consumer credit commissioner, 2 or the credit union commissioner.

3 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a 4 license issued or renewed on or after the effective date of this 5 Act.

6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
