7	SECTION 1. Chapter 531, Government Code, is amended by
8	adding Subchapter I-1 to read as follows:
9	SUBCHAPTER I-1. ALTERNATIVE MENTAL HEALTH THERAPIES
10	Sec. 531.331. ALTERNATIVE MENTAL HEALTH THERAPY RESEARCH
11	CONSORTIUM. (a) In this section, "consortium" means the Texas
12	Alternative Mental Health Therapy Research Consortium.
13	(b) The commission shall establish the Texas Alternative
14	Mental Health Therapy Research Consortium.
15	(c) The consortium is composed of:
16	(1) academic scholars with knowledge of the efficacy
17	of providing mental health therapy using psychedelics;
18	(2) representatives of health-related institutions
19	providing alternative mental health therapies using ketamine;
20	(3) mental health professionals who specialize in
21	providing mental health care to veterans; and
22	(4) representatives of an advocacy group for
23	alternative mental health therapies using psychedelics.
24	(d) The executive commissioner shall appoint the members of

1 the consortium.

2 <u>(e) The consortium shall research the efficacy of providing</u> 3 <u>mental health care through the provision of psychedelic drugs and</u> 4 <u>ketamine, focusing on the provision of mental health care to</u> 5 <u>veterans in this state through the use of those alternative</u> 6 <u>therapies.</u>

7 (f) The consortium shall solicit, and the commission may 8 accept on behalf of the consortium, a gift, grant, or donation made 9 from any public or private source to accomplish the purposes of this 10 section.

Sec. 531.332. GRANT PROGRAM FOR KETAMINE CLINICS. (a) The commission shall establish and administer a grant program to establish ketamine clinics in this state.

14 (b) In addition to money appropriated by the legislature, 15 the commission may accept gifts, grants, or donations from any 16 source to administer and finance the grant program established 17 under this section.

18 Sec. 531.333. PLAN FOR KETAMINE THERAPY VOUCHER PROGRAM FOR
 19 VETERANS. The commission shall develop a plan to establish a
 20 voucher program to provide ketamine therapy to veterans.

21 <u>Sec. 531.334. RULES. The executive commissioner shall</u>
22 <u>adopt rules to implement this subchapter.</u>

23 SECTION 2. (a) The Health and Human Services Commission 24 shall conduct a study to evaluate the efficacy of using alternative 25 therapies, including the use of ibogaine and 5-MeO-DMT, to treat 26 veterans who suffer from post-traumatic stress disorder, 27 depression, and mild traumatic brain injury.

(b) As part of the study conducted under Subsection (a) of 1 this section, the commission must review scientific literature 2 3 related to alternative therapies.

(c) Not later than December 1, 2024, the Health and Human 4 Services Commission shall prepare and submit a report to the 5 6 legislature containing the findings of the study and any recommendations for legislative action. 7

(d) This section expires September 1, 2025.
