A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the regulation of the practice of pharmacy.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 559.003(e), Occupations Code, is amended 5 to read as follows:

6 (e) <u>The board may refuse to</u> [A person may not] renew a 7 license to practice pharmacy if the person holds a license to 8 practice pharmacy in another state that has been suspended, 9 revoked, canceled, or subject to an action that prohibits the 10 person from practicing pharmacy in that state.

11 SECTION 2. Section 565.002(c), Occupations Code, is
12 repealed.

13 SECTION 3. Section 559.003(e), Occupations Code, as amended 14 by this Act, applies only to a pharmacy license that expires on or 15 after the effective date of this Act. A pharmacy license that 16 expires before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law 17 in effect on the date the license expired, and the former law is 18 continued in effect for that purpose.

19 SECTION 4. The repeal by this Act of Section 565.002(c), 20 Occupations Code, applies only to a disciplinary action commenced 21 on or after the effective date of this Act. A disciplinary action 22 commenced before the effective date of this Act is governed by the 23 law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and 24 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
