H.B. No. 4583

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the prescribing of opioids for acute pain.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section [481.07636](#), Health and Safety Code, is
5 amended to read as follows:

6 Sec. 481.07636. OPIOID PRESCRIPTION LIMITS. (a) In this
7 section, "acute pain" means the normal, predicted, physiological
8 response to a stimulus such as trauma, disease, and operative
9 procedures. Acute pain is time limited. The term does not include:

- 10 (1) chronic pain;
- 11 (2) pain being treated as part of cancer care;
- 12 (3) pain being treated as part of hospice or other
13 end-of-life care; or
- 14 (4) pain being treated as part of palliative care.

15 (b) For the treatment of acute pain, a practitioner may not:

- 16 (1) issue a prescription for an opioid in an amount
17 that exceeds a 10-day supply; or
- 18 (2) provide for a refill of an opioid.

19 (c) Subsection (b) does not apply to a prescription for an
20 opioid approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration
21 for the treatment of substance addiction that is issued by a
22 practitioner for the treatment of substance addiction.

23 (d) A dispenser is not subject to criminal, civil, or
24 administrative penalties for dispensing or refusing to dispense a

1 controlled substance under a prescription that exceeds the limits
2 provided by Subsection (b).

3 (e) A practitioner shall refer or prescribe any of the
4 following non-pharmacological pain management services to a
5 patient, based on the prescriber's clinical judgment and the
6 availability of the treatment, when issuing an opioid prescription
7 for acute pain:

8 (1) chiropractic treatment;

9 (2) physical therapies;

10 (3) occupational therapies;

11 (4) physical medicine and rehabilitation; or

12 (5) osteopathic manipulation.

13 (f) Nothing in this Section shall require that all
14 treatments set forth in Subsection 481.07636 (e) be exhausted prior
15 to the patient receiving a prescription for an opioid.
