A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to notifications by the Department of Agriculture of
3	certain stop-sale orders applicable to plant products and the
4	seizure or destruction of certain plant products.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 12.0012, Agriculture Code, is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	Sec. 12.0012. NOTIFICATIONS [NOTIFICATION]. (a) The
9	department shall, upon submission for publication, notify the Texas
10	Division of Emergency Management of each quarantine it adopts. The
11	department shall thereafter cooperate with the Texas Division of
12	Emergency Management in implementing any necessary safeguards to
13	protect the state's agricultural resources from potential
14	economic, health, or ecological disaster that may result from the
15	quarantined pest or disease.
16	(b) The department shall notify the governor, lieutenant
17	governor, speaker of the house of representatives, and chairs of
18	the house and senate committees with primary jurisdiction over the
19	department of:

authorized by the department.

(1) a stop-sale order under Section 18.010, 19.011, or

(2) the seizure or destruction of any plant product

(c) A notification issued under Subsection (b) must be made

- 1 within 24 hours of the issuance of the order or the action taken by
- 2 the department and must include:
- 3 (1) the date and time of the order or action;
- 4 (2) the location of the plant product barred from
- 5 sale, seized, or destroyed;
- 6 (3) the reason for the order or action, including the
- 7 agency rule and statute used as justification for the order or
- 8 action;
- 9 (4) the type and quantity of the plant product barred
- 10 from sale, seized, or destroyed;
- 11 (5) if known, the name and contact information of the
- 12 owner or operator responsible for the plant product;
- 13 (6) the name and contact information of the inspector
- 14 or other person responsible for the order or action; and
- 15 (7) any other information considered relevant by the
- 16 department.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
