| 14 | (2) "High-volume business" means a business operating              |
| 15 | in this state that regularly accommodates at least 1,000           |
| 16 | individuals per hour on the business premises at some time during  |
| 17 | the business's normal business hours.                              |
| 18 | Sec. 121.002. IMPLEMENTATION OF CELLULAR ENHANCEMENT               |
| 19 | TECHNOLOGY BY CERTAIN HIGH-VOLUME BUSINESSES. A high-volume        |
| 20 | business that provides or supports the use of an Internet          |
| 21 | application for use by a customer on the business premises may     |
| 22 | deploy cellular enhancement technology to ensure adequate wireless |
