relating to the creation of a temporary teaching certificate for
teachers certified by other states.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
amended by adding Section 21.0521 to read as follows:
Sec. 21.0521. TEMPORARY CERTIFICATION OF TEACHERS FROM
OUTSIDE THIS STATE. (a) The board shall:
(1) establish a temporary teaching certificate for
classroom teachers certified by other states; and
(2) immediately issue a certificate described by
Subdivision (1) to an applicant for the certificate who meets the
eligibility requirements under Subsection (b).
(b) To be eligible for a certificate issued under this
section, a person must:

- (1) hold a valid, unexpired certificate or similar 16
- 17 credential in another state that qualifies the person to provide
- classroom instruction in that state; 18
- (2) possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited 19
- college or university; and 20
- (3) have applied for a certificate issued under 21
- 22 Section 21.052.
- (c) A certificate issued under this section expires on the 23
- earlier of: 24

- 1 (1) the first anniversary of the date the certificate
- 2 <u>is issued; or</u>
- 3 (2) the date the person is issued a certificate under
- 4 Section 21.052.
- 5 (d) A certificate issued under this section may not be
- 6 reissued or renewed.
- 7 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 8 of this Act, the State Board for Educator Certification shall adopt
- 9 rules necessary to implement this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
