- 2 relating to the qualifications and summoning of grand jurors.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article 19A.052, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Art. 19A.052. QUALIFIED PERSONS SUMMONED. On directing the
- 7 sheriff or clerk of the district court to summon grand jurors, the
- 8 court shall instruct the sheriff or clerk of the district court to
- 9 not summon a person to serve as a grand juror who does not possess
- 10 the qualifications prescribed by law.
- 11 SECTION 2. Article 19A.053, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 Art. 19A.053. ADDITIONAL QUALIFIED PERSONS SUMMONED. (a)
- 14 If fewer than 16 persons summoned to serve as grand jurors are found
- 15 to be in attendance and qualified to serve, the court shall order
- 16 the sheriff or clerk of the district court to summon an additional
- 17 number of persons considered necessary to constitute a grand jury
- 18 of 12 grand jurors and four alternate grand jurors.
- 19 (b) The sheriff or clerk of the district court shall summon
- 20 the additional prospective grand jurors under Subsection (a) in
- 21 person to attend before the court immediately.
- 22 SECTION 3. Article 19A.101, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- 24 Art. 19A.101. GRAND JUROR QUALIFICATIONS. (a) A person may

- 1 be selected or serve as a grand juror only if the person:
- 2 (1) is at least 18 years of age;
- 3 (2) is a citizen of the United States;
- 4 (3) is a resident of this state and of the county in
- 5 which the person is to serve;
- 6 (4) is qualified under the constitution and other laws
- 7 to vote in the county in which the grand jury is sitting, regardless
- 8 of whether the person is registered to vote;
- 9 (5) is of sound mind and good moral character;
- 10 (6) is able to read and write;
- 11 (7) has never [not] been convicted of misdemeanor
- 12 theft or a felony;
- 13 (8) is not under indictment or other legal accusation
- 14 for misdemeanor theft or a felony;
- 15 (9) is not related within the third degree by
- 16 consanguinity or second degree by affinity, as determined under
- 17 Chapter 573, Government Code, to any person selected to serve or
- 18 serving on the same grand jury;
- 19 (10) has not served as a grand juror in the year before
- 20 the date on which the term of court for which the person has been
- 21 selected as a grand juror begins; and
- 22 (11) is not a complainant in any matter to be heard by
- 23 the grand jury during the term of court for which the person has
- 24 been selected as a grand juror.
- 25 (b) On the third business day of each month, the clerk of the
- 26 district court shall prepare a list of persons who in the preceding
- 27 month were disqualified from serving as a grand juror based on the

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- 1 person's citizenship or indictment or conviction for misdemeanor
- 2 theft or a felony and send a copy of the list to:
- 3 (1) the secretary of state; and
- 4 (2) the prosecuting attorney for the court to which
- 5 the grand jurors were summoned for investigation into whether any
- 6 person made a false claim concerning the person's qualification
- 7 under Subsection (a)(2), (7), or (8).
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act applies only to the summoning of grand
- 9 jurors on or after the effective date of this Act. The summoning of
- 10 grand jurors before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 11 the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 12 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
