- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 127.201, Election Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsections (a), (b), and (c) and adding Subsection (a-1)
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) To ensure the accuracy of the tabulation of electronic
- 8 voting system results, the general custodian of election records
- 9 shall conduct a manual count of all the races in:
- 10 (1) at least one percent of the election precincts or
- 11 in three precincts, whichever is greater, in which the electronic
- 12 voting system was used; or
- 13 (2) at least one percent of polling places
- 14 participating in the countywide polling place program under Section
- 15 43.007 or in three countywide polling places, whichever is greater,
- 16 in which the electronic voting system was used on election day and
- 17 during early voting by personal appearance.
- 18 $\underline{(a-1)}$ The custodian shall select the precincts \underline{or}
- 19 countywide polling places for a manual count under Subsection (a)
- 20 at random and shall begin the count not later than 72 hours after
- 21 the polls close. The count shall be completed not later than the
- 22 21st day after election day. Subsection (b) supersedes this
- 23 subsection to the extent of a conflict.
- (b) In a general election for state and county officers,

- 1 primary election, or election on a proposed amendment to the state
- 2 constitution or other statewide measure submitted by the
- B legislature, the secretary of state shall select, in accordance
- 4 with rules adopted by the secretary, the precincts or countywide
- 5 polling places to be counted under Subsection (a). The secretary
- 6 shall designate not more than three offices and not more than three
- 7 propositions to be counted in the selected precincts or countywide
- 8 polling places. The secretary shall notify the general custodian
- 9 of election records of the precincts or countywide polling places,
- 10 offices, and propositions selected under this subsection not
- 11 earlier than the day after election day.
- 12 (c) On selection or notification, as applicable, of the
- 13 precincts or countywide polling places to be counted, the general
- 14 custodian of election records shall post on the county's Internet
- 15 website home page [in the custodian's office] a notice of the date,
- 16 hour, and place of the count.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
