Chapter 140, Local Government Code, is amended 7 by adding Section 140.0046 to read as follows: Sec. 140.0046. LIMITATION ON AUTHORITY TO REDUCE BUDGET FOR 8 9 PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES. (a) In this section: (1) "Comparable service" means: 10 11 (A) the services provided by a department or 12 similar unit of a political subdivision that are identifiable in the political subdivision's budget, if the political subdivision is 13 14 separated into departments or similar units; or 15 (B) a service provided by a political subdivision 16 that is identifiable in the political subdivision's budget, if the political subdivision is not separated into units described by 17 Paragraph (A). 18 (2) "Public safety service" means a fire protection, 19 law enforcement, or emergency medical service. 20 21 (b) This section does not apply to a school district. (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a political 22 23 subdivision may not adopt a budget that allocates an amount of money to provide a public safety service that is less than the amount 24

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1 allocated to provide that service in the preceding fiscal year if: 2 (1) the reduction in the amount of money allocated to 3 provide the public safety service is greater than the reduction in the amount of money allocated in that budget to provide a comparable 4 service if compared to the amounts allocated to provide those 5 services in the preceding fiscal year; and 6 7 (2) the percentage difference between the amount of 8 money allocated in that budget to provide the public safety service and the amount allocated to provide that service in the preceding 9 fiscal year is greater than the percentage difference between the 10 amount of money allocated in that budget to provide the comparable 11 12 service and the amount allocated to provide that comparable service 13 in the preceding fiscal year. 14 (d) A political subdivision may adopt a budget that does not 15 meet the requirements of Subsection (c) as it relates to a public safety service if the political subdivision will not provide that 16 17 service in the fiscal year for which the budget is adopted. (e) For purposes of this section, the amount of money 18 19 allocated to provide a service includes all maintenance, operations, and debt service costs associated with providing the 20 service. 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 22 to a budget adopted by a political subdivision on or after the 23 24 effective date of this Act.

25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
