- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 64.0322(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (b) The secretary of state shall prescribe the form required
- 7 by this section. The form must be incorporated into the official
- 8 carrier envelope or signature sheet contained in the official
- 9 carrier envelope if the voter is voting an early voting ballot by
- 10 mail and receives assistance under Section 86.010, or must be
- 11 submitted to an election officer at the time the voter casts a
- 12 ballot if the voter is voting at a polling place or under Section
- 13 64.009.
- SECTION 2. Sections 86.002(b) and (g), Election Code, are
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (b) Before providing the balloting materials to the voter,
- 17 the clerk shall enter on the signature sheet contained in the
- 18 carrier envelope the identity and date of the election.
- 19 (g) The <u>signature sheet contained in the</u> carrier envelope
- 20 must include a space [that is hidden from view when the envelope is
- 21 sealed] for the voter to enter the following information:
- 22 (1) the number of the voter's driver's license,
- 23 election identification certificate, or personal identification
- 24 card issued by the Department of Public Safety;

- 4 (3) a statement by the applicant that the applicant

- 6 SECTION 3. Section 86.010(e), Election Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (e) A person who assists a voter to prepare a ballot to be
- 9 voted by mail shall enter on:
- 10 $\underline{(1)}$ the official carrier envelope of the voter [+
- 11 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ the person's signature, printed name, and
- 12 residence address; and
- 13 (2) the signature sheet contained in the official
- 14 carrier envelope:
- 15 $\underline{\text{(A)}}$ the relationship of the person providing the
- 16 assistance to the voter; and
- (B) $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$ whether the person received or
- 18 accepted any form of compensation or other benefit from a
- 19 candidate, campaign, or political committee in exchange for
- 20 providing assistance.
- 21 SECTION 4. Section 86.013, Election Code, is amended by
- 22 amending Subsections (b), (d), (e), (f), and (g) and adding
- 23 Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 24 (b) Spaces must appear on the <u>signature sheet contained in</u>
- 25 [reverse side of] the official carrier envelope for:
- 26 (1) indicating the identity and date of the election;
- 27 (2) entering the signature, printed name, and

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- 1 residence address of a person other than the voter who deposits the
- 2 carrier envelope in the mail or with a common or contract carrier;
- 3 and
- 4 (3) indicating the relationship of that person to the
- 5 voter.
- 6 (d) The following textual material, as prescribed by the
- 7 secretary of state, must be printed on the signature sheet
- 8 contained in [reverse side of] the official carrier envelope [or on
- 9 a separate sheet accompanying the carrier envelope] when it is
- 10 provided:
- 11 (1) the prohibition prescribed by Section 86.006(b);
- 12 (2) the conditions for delivery by common or contract
- 13 carrier prescribed by Sections 81.005 and 86.006;
- 14 (3) the requirements for the legal execution and
- 15 delivery of the carrier envelope, including the prohibition on
- 16 compensation for depositing carrier envelopes containing ballots
- 17 voted by other persons under Section 86.0052;
- 18 (4) the prohibition prescribed by Section 86.006(e);
- 19 and
- 20 (5) the offenses prescribed by Sections 86.006(f) and
- 21 86.010(f).
- (e) The following notice must be printed on the signature
- 23 sheet contained in [reverse side of] the official carrier envelope,
- 24 near the space provided for the voter's signature: "This envelope
- 25 must be sealed by the voter before it leaves the voter's hands. Do
- 26 not sign this envelope unless the ballot has been marked by you or
- 27 at your direction."

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- 1 (f) The oath of a person assisting a voter must be included 2 on the <u>signature sheet contained in the</u> official carrier envelope 3 as part of the certificate prescribed by Subsection (c).
- (g) The secretary of state by rule shall require that a notice informing voters of the telephone number established under Section 31.0055 and the purpose of the telephone number be printed on the signature sheet [+
- 8 [(1) the official carrier envelope; or
- 9 [(2) an insert] enclosed with the balloting materials
 10 for voting by mail sent to the voter.
- 11 (h) The secretary of state shall prescribe the form and
 12 content of the signature sheet that satisfies requirements of this
 13 code.
- SECTION 5. Section 272.011(b), Election Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 16 (b) The secretary of state shall prepare the translation for 17 election materials required to be provided in a language other than 18 English or Spanish for the following state prescribed voter forms:
- 19 (1) voter registration application form required by
- 20 Section 13.002;
- 21 (2) the confirmation form required by Section 15.051;
- 22 (3) the voting instruction poster required by Section
- 23 62.011;
- 24 (4) the reasonable impediment declaration required by
- 25 Section 63.001(b);
- 26 (5) the statement of residence form required by
- 27 Section 63.0011;

- 1 (6) the provisional ballot affidavit required by
- 2 Section 63.011;
- 3 (7) the application for a ballot by mail required by
- 4 Section 84.011;
- 5 (8) the carrier envelope, signature sheet, and voting
- 6 instructions required by Section 86.013; and
- 7 (9) any other voter forms that the secretary of state
- 8 identifies as frequently used and for which state resources are
- 9 otherwise available.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
