| 12 | (a) Notwithstanding Section 19.004, each voter registrar may use    |
| 13 | state funds disbursed under this subchapter or Chapter 19 to        |
| 14 | promote voter registration or voting participation in a county.     |
| 15 | (b) A voter registrar may promote:                                  |
| 16 | (1) voter registration, by identifying persons                      |
| 17 | eligible for registration and encouraging the identified persons to |
| 18 | register to vote; and   |
| 19 | (2) voting participation, by encouraging registered                 |

(c) A voter registrar that promotes voter registration or 1 2 voting participation under Subsection (b)(1) or (2) may not: 3 (1) promote any particular party, candidate, or group 4 of candidates; or 5 (2) target the voter registrar's efforts toward 6 individuals on the basis of race, ethnicity, or sex. 7 (d) A voter registrar may contract with a nonprofit organization to carry out the promotion of voter registration or 8 voting participation permitted under this section. 9 Sec. 18.083. FUNDING. A voter registrar may use any 10 available revenue, including legislative appropriations, and may 11 solicit and accept gifts, grants, and donations from a public or 12 private source for the purposes of this subchapter. 13
