4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 826, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 826.0425 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 826.0425. PROHIBITED REQUIREMENT OF CERTAIN REPORTS OR
8	QUARANTINE. The executive commissioner may not adopt a rule to
9	require:
10	(1) a person to report an incident involving an animal
11	bite or scratch if:
12	(A) the bite or scratch was from a domesticated
13	dog, cat, or ferret; and
14	(B) the person does not reasonably foresee the
15	dog, cat, or ferret as capable of transmitting rabies and does not
16	suspect the dog, cat, or ferret is rabid; or
17	(2) the owner of a domesticated dog, cat, or ferret to
18	submit the animal to quarantine under this chapter if the owner
19	lacks probable cause to believe the animal is rabid or may have been
20	exposed to rabies.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
