A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the employment of armed commissioned security officers

- 3 as school district security personnel.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.081(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The board of trustees of any school district may employ
- 8 security personnel, enter into a memorandum of understanding with a
- 9 local law enforcement agency for the provision of school resource
- 10 officers, and commission peace officers to carry out this
- 11 subchapter. If a board of trustees authorizes a person employed as
- 12 security personnel to carry a weapon, the person must be a
- 13 commissioned peace officer or a commissioned security officer
- 14 licensed under Subchapter G, Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, who
- 15 has completed the training program provided under Section 1701.260,
- 16 Occupations Code. The jurisdiction of a peace officer, a school
- 17 resource officer, or security personnel under this section shall be
- 18 determined by the board of trustees and may include all territory in
- 19 the boundaries of the school district and all property outside the
- 20 boundaries of the district that is owned, leased, or rented by or
- 21 otherwise under the control of the school district and the board of
- 22 trustees that employ the peace officer or security personnel or
- 23 that enter into a memorandum of understanding for the provision of a
- 24 school resource officer.

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 2 school year.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
